

Getting Pictures On-Line



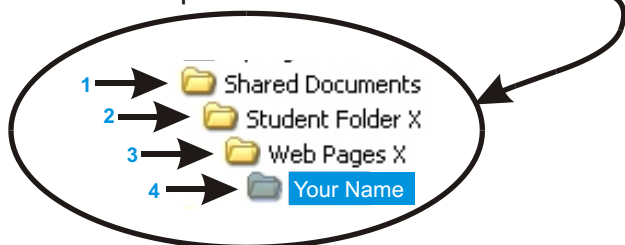
When getting pictures from the Internet make sure you try to get a picture that has the highest resolution possible. The higher the resolution the better quality the photo will be. We can always shrink an image, but enlarging images make them appear to be "pixilated" or "grainy" looking.

Before you start, make sure you open your web page file in "Dreamweaver"

1. Open the program called "Internet Explorer"
2. Find the picture you want on the internet.
3. Move the mouse over the image and click the right mouse button once. A menu should appear. Scroll down and select "Save Picture As..."

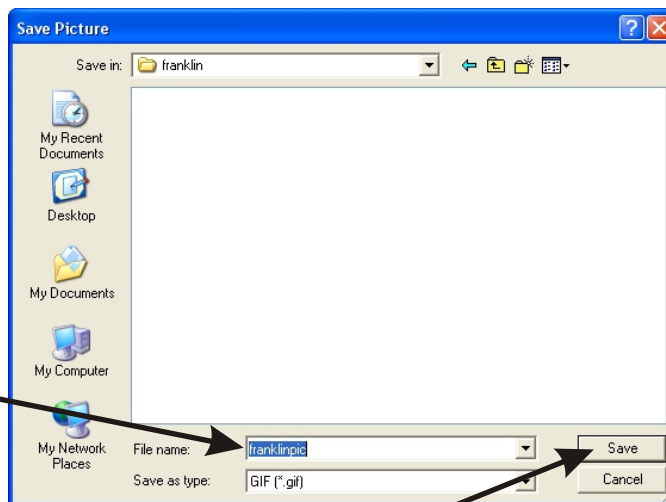


4. Put the picture in the correct folder.



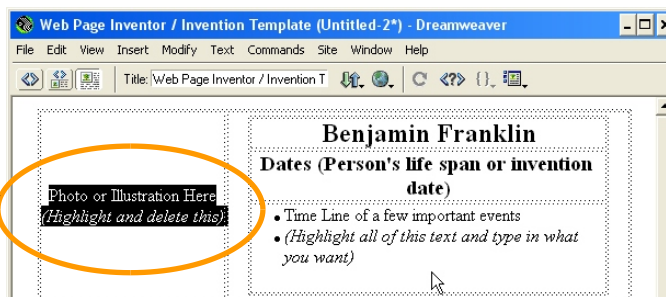
5. When the following window appears, name the picture something easy to remember. For Example: "franklinpic"

IMPORTANT: Do not put any spaces or other characters in the file name..

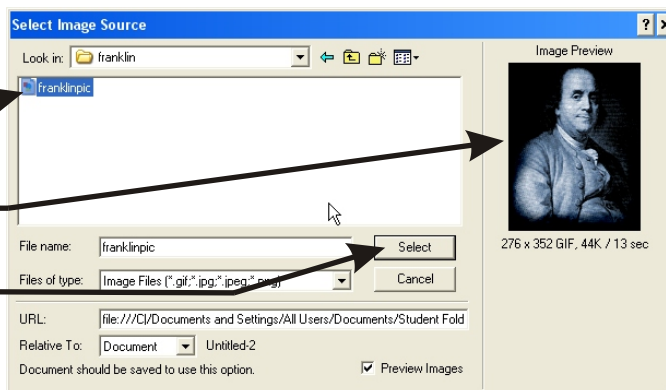


6. Now click the "Save" button.

7. Now open your web page file in "Dreamweaver"
8. Highlight the text that reads; "Photo or Illustration Here" and press "Backspace" once.
9. From the menu, select "Insert", "Image"



10. Select the picture file in your web page folder. You should see a preview of your photo in the box to the right.



11. Finally click on the "Select" button and your photo should be placed in your web page.
12. Repeat these steps for every image you would like to insert in your web page. Resize the pictures to fit.
