



# Making Links



When you create links, be sure not to use sites that have the same information that you are using to create your web page. Links should be related to your inventor, and should include something interesting for kids to browse. Example; pictures, illustrations, experiments, facts, games, etc.

**Before you start, make sure you open your web page file in "Dreamweaver"**

1. Open the program called "Internet Explorer"
2. Find the link (web page) you want on the internet
3. Use the mouse to highlight the URL address of the web site. It should begin with **http://www.**
4. Copy the URL by selecting **Edit, Copy** from the menu or press the "Ctrl" & "C" keys at the same time



5. Open your web page in "Dreamweaver"
6. Scroll down the page and highlight one of the example links already created.
7. Name the link so who ever sees it will be able to tell what he/she is going to be linked to.

**For example: "Click HERE to try an electricity experiment"**



8. Make sure the "Properties" window is open  
**IF NOT: Select "Window" from the menu and select "Properties"**
9. Make sure the name of the link is still highlighted
10. Now highlight the example URL address in the "Properties" window




11. Paste the URL address that you copied from the internet, by pressing "Ctrl" & "V" at the same time then press the "Enter" key.  
**DO NOT use the "Edit" & "Paste" command from the menu. This will replace your link text instead of the URL address**

12. Repeat steps 4 through 10 for all 3 of your links

13. "Save" your work

14. Preview your web page in "Internet Explorer"

15. Go to your web page folder and double click on your web page
